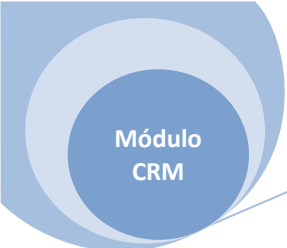

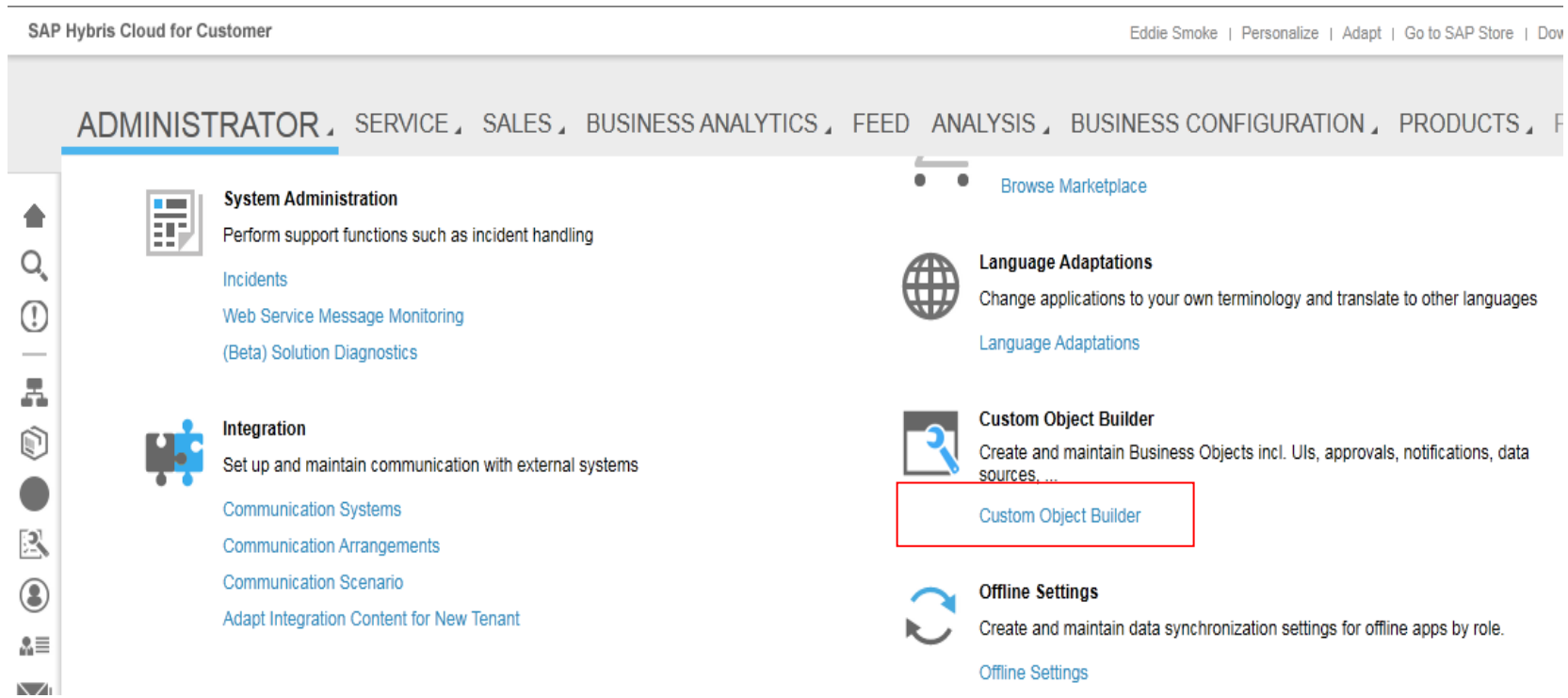

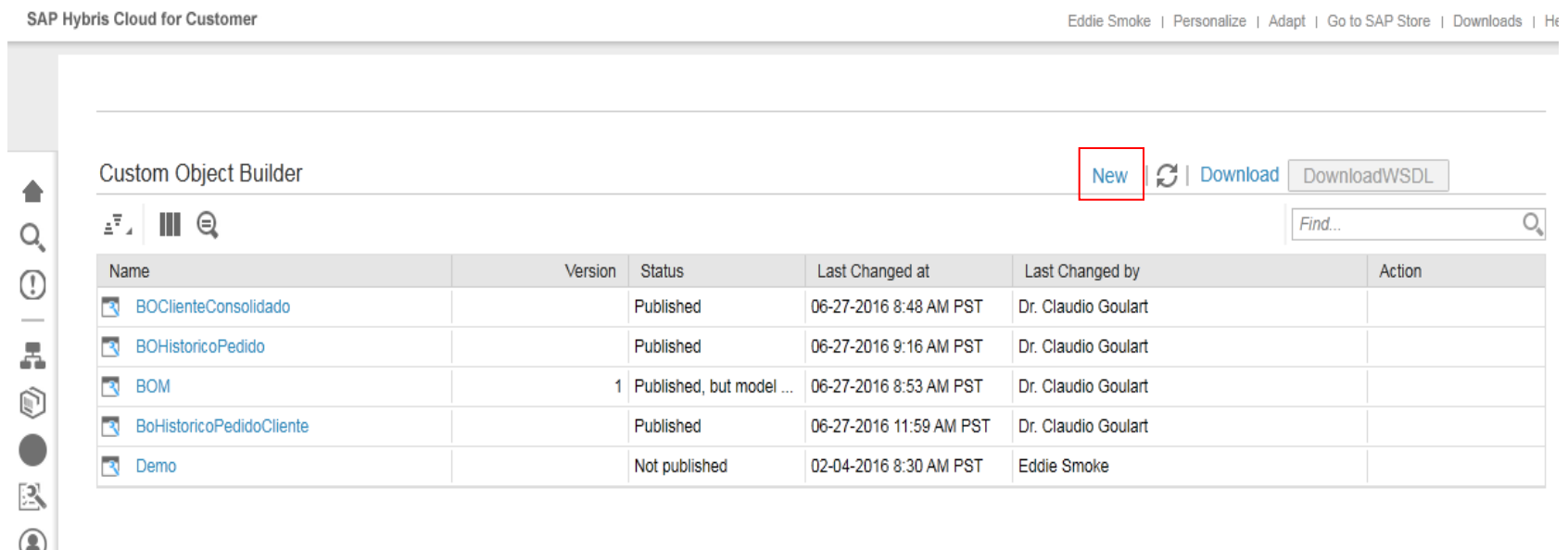
### 1.2. Creating a Custom Object

This step will be create a Business Object customized without "A" line of code on SDK.

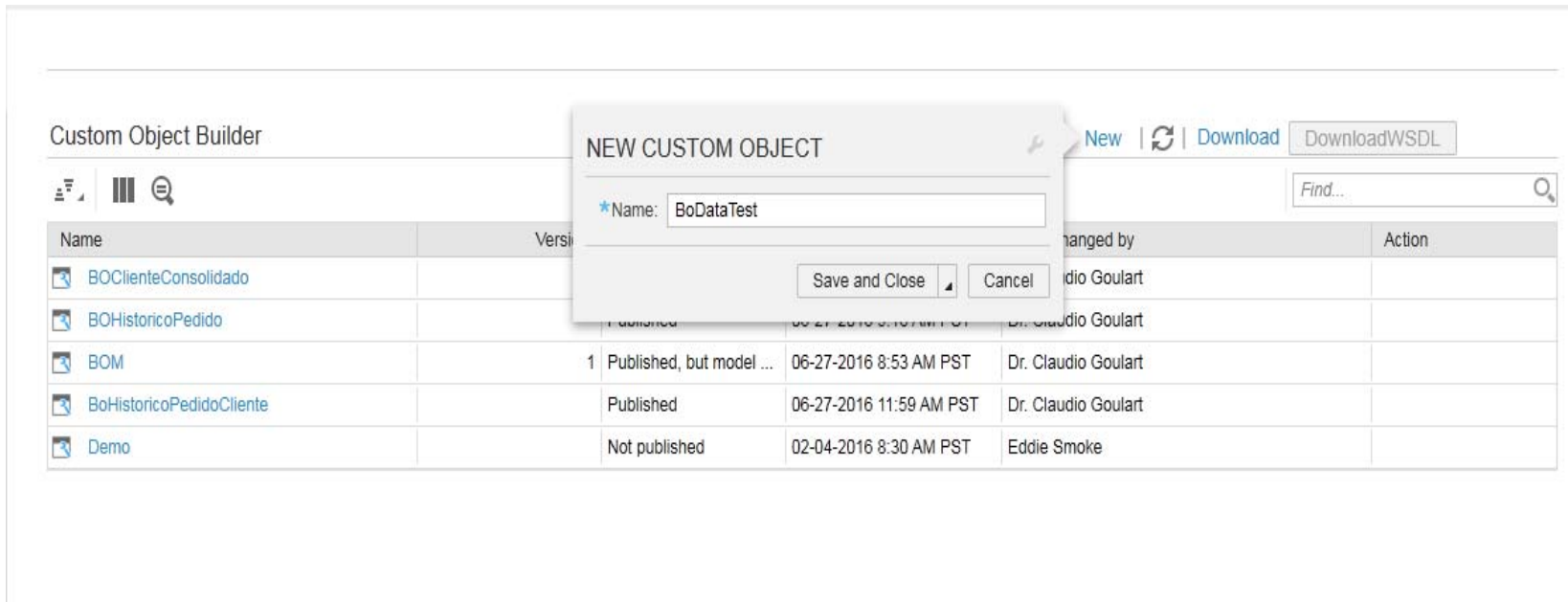
Select on Administrator->Custom Object Builder link below



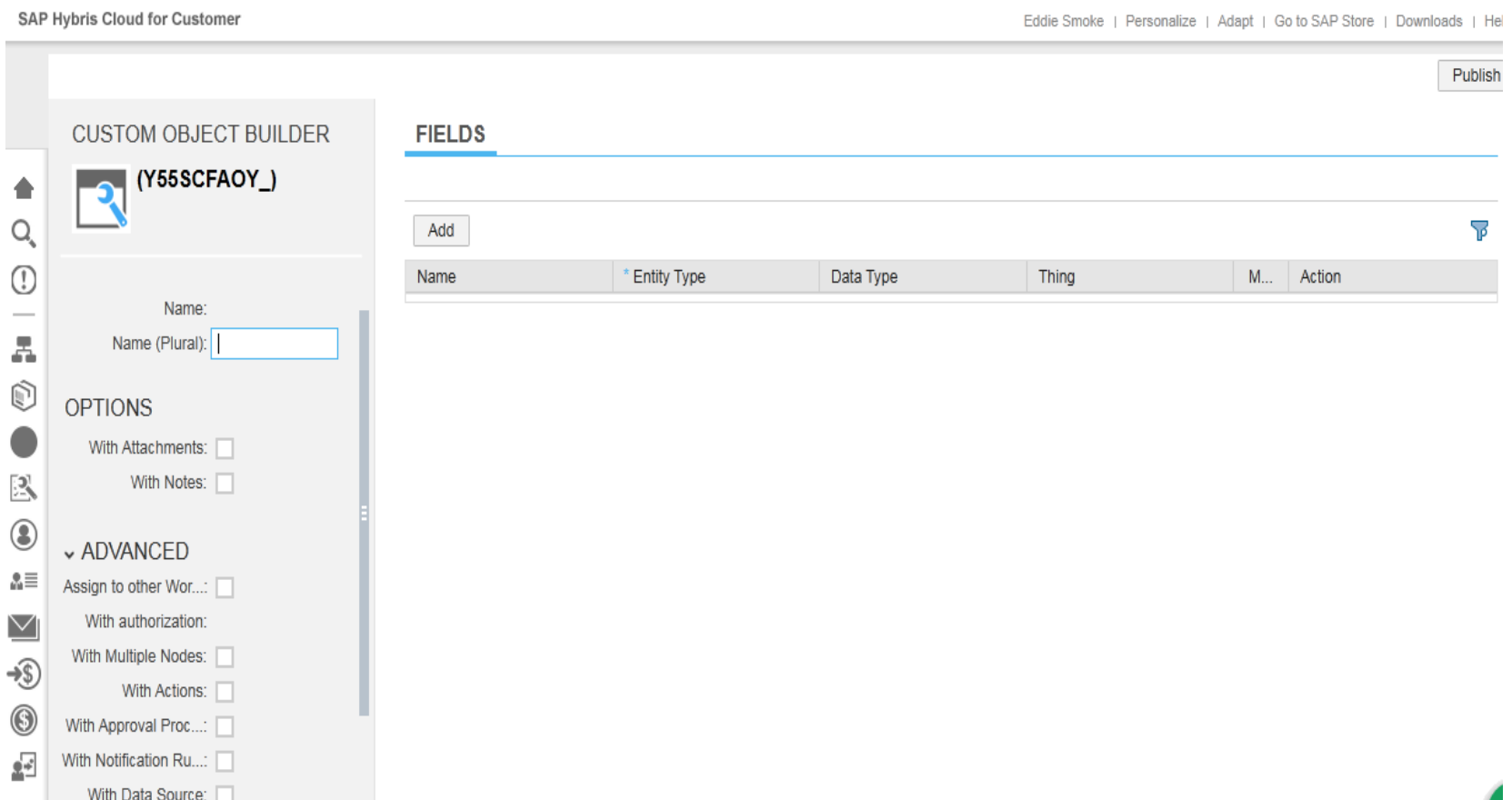
The Custom Object Builder screen appeared listing all Custom BOs existents, and then select the New Button to create a new BO

On the right will be necessary define a list of fields of your BO, and of course I defined some fields to full fill our test.

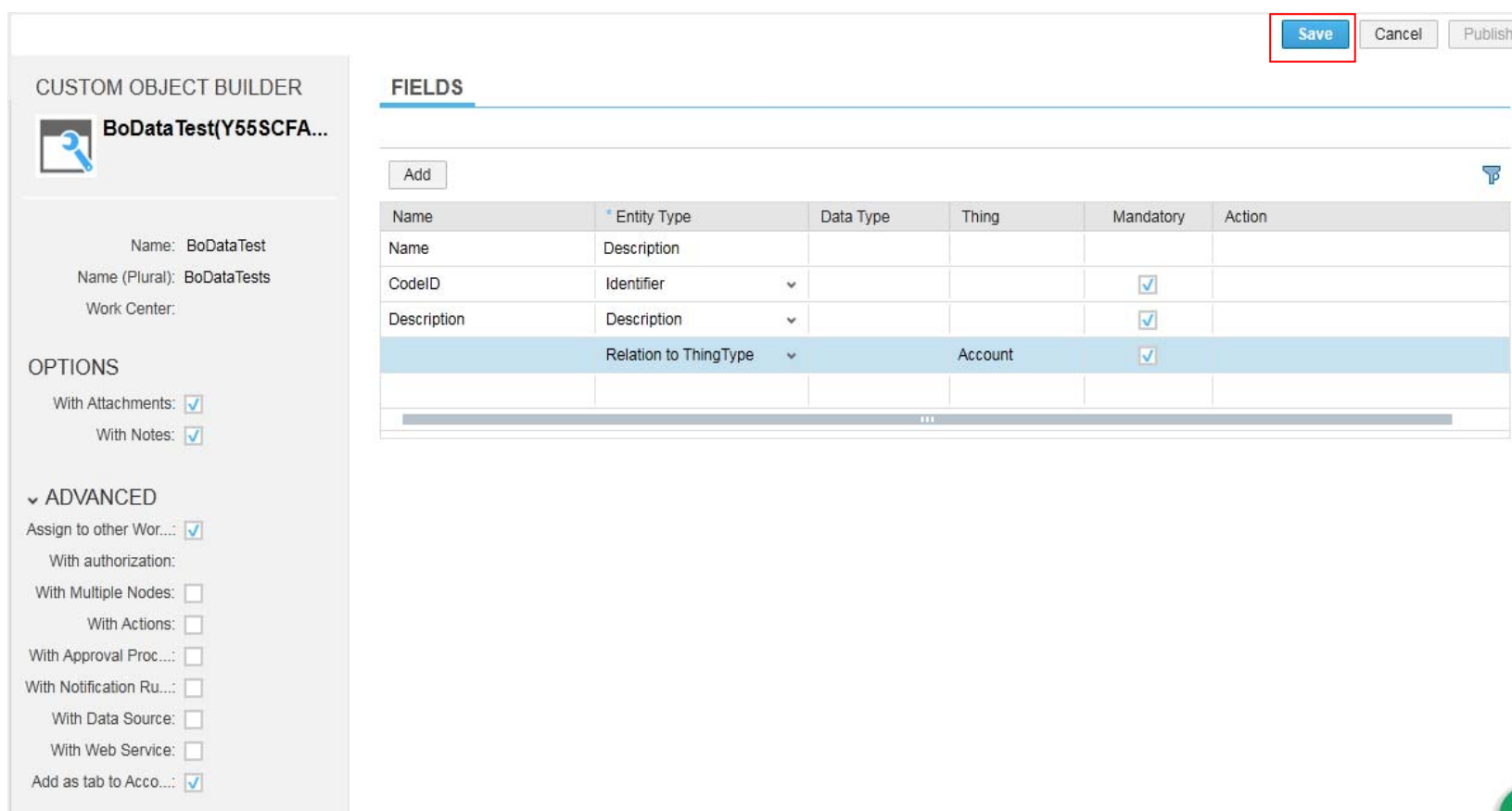
As we define a relationship between Customer and our Business Object it's necessary create a field to relate the Customer (Account)

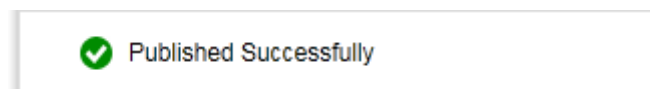
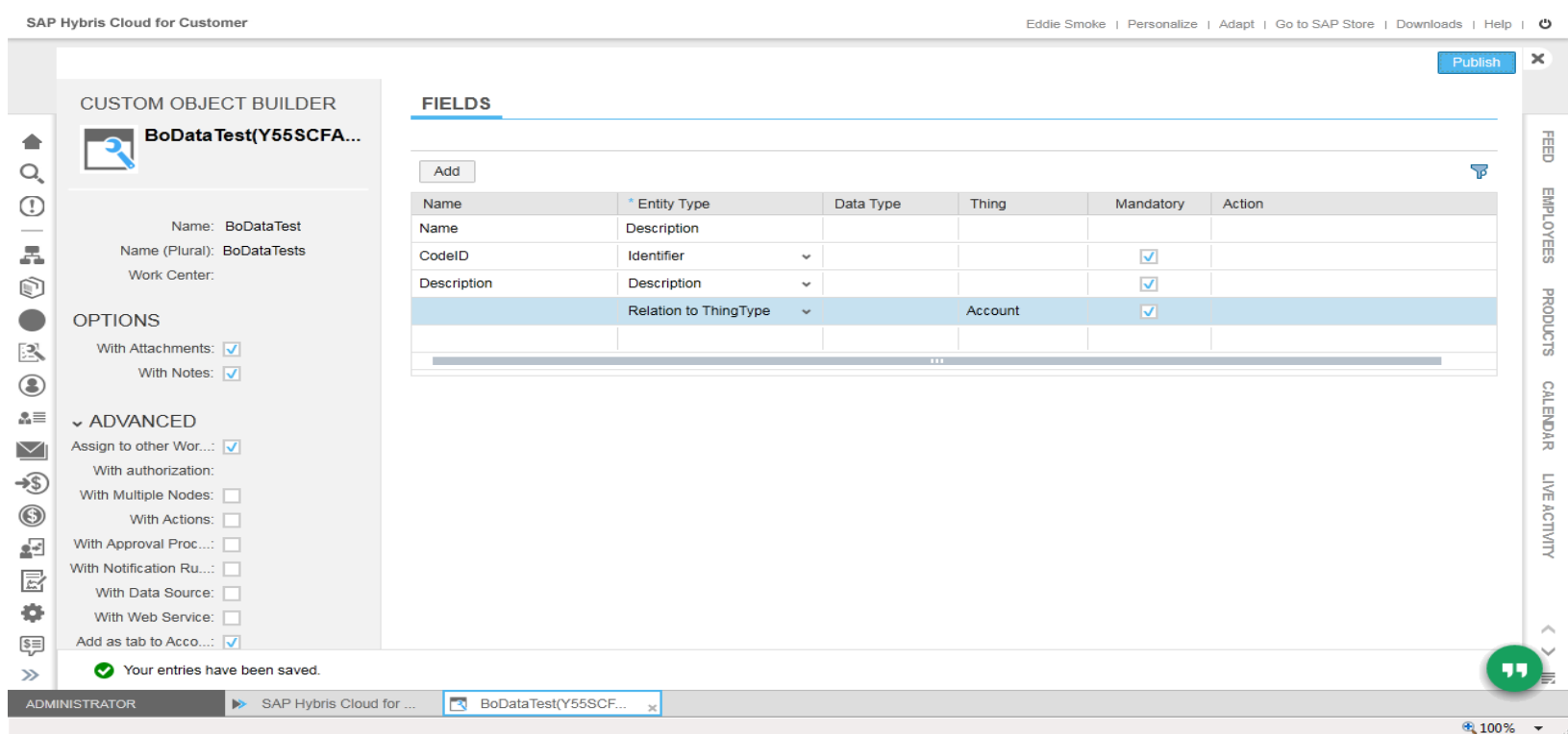

And then Save the Custom BO



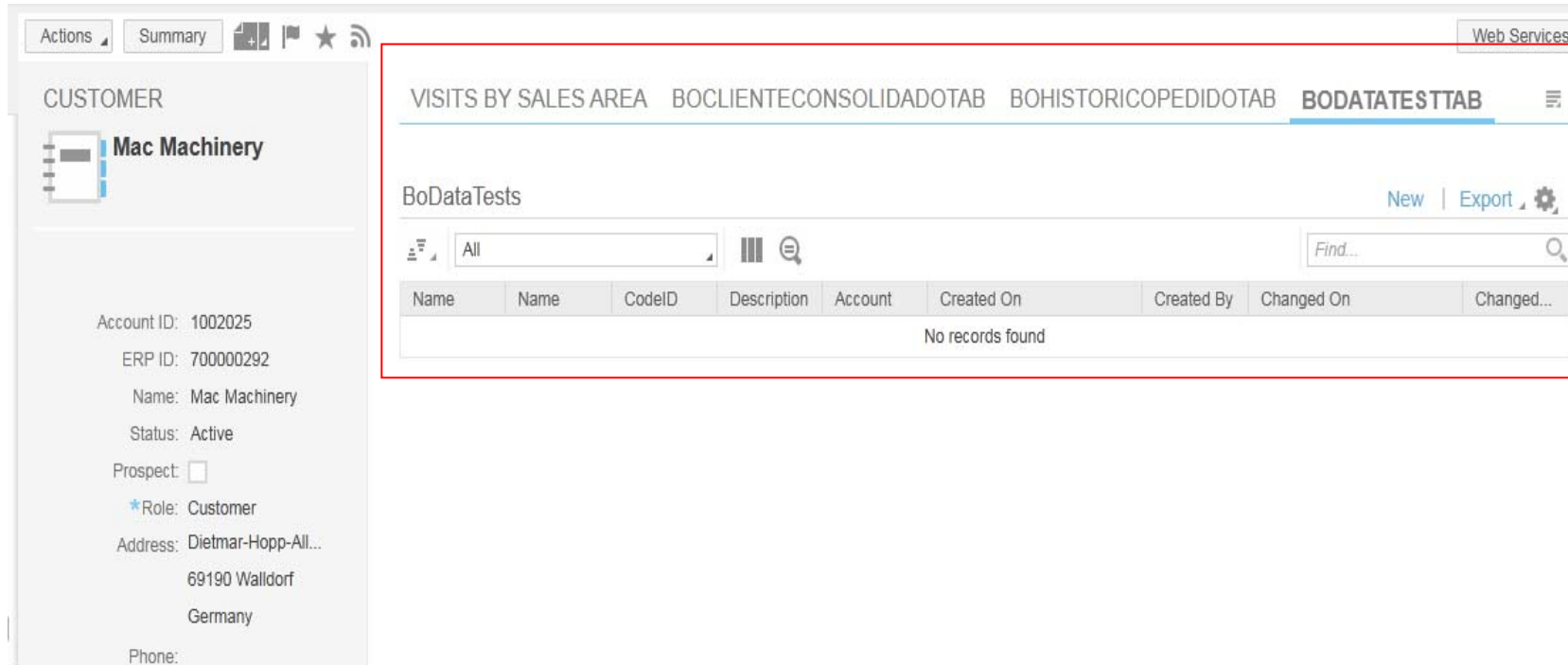
And then publish your BO. This action it's necessary to make our BO available to the system.
